

UNAPPROVED MINUTES
CITY OF MILO ORGANIZATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING
CITY HALL, 100 MAIN ST., MILO, IOWA
TUESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2020 AT 6:30 PM

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 6:32 p.m. Council answering roll call: Moulds, Graham and Uttley and Mason. Kinser was absent. Motion by Graham to approve the agenda. Second by Mason. Ayes-all. Motion carried.

Motion by Moulds to set the regular Milo City Council meetings for the 1st Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. and reserve the 3rd Monday of each month as an optional meeting. Second by Mason. Ayes-All present. Motion carried. Motion by Moulds to designate the Indianola Record Herald as the official publication place for all official notices except minutes and wages which will be published in the Milo Newsletter. Council meeting minutes will be posted under the government tab on the City of Milo website and physically posted at City Hall, Post Office and Milo Public Library. Second by Graham. Ayes-All present. Motion carried. Motion by Mason to designate People's Bank, Milo, Iowa and Greater Iowa Credit Union, Indianola, Iowa as the official bank depositories for the City of Milo, Iowa. Second by Uttley. Ayes-All present. Motion carried. Motion by Moulds to appoint The Iowa Clinic, 1504 N 1st Street, Indianola, Iowa as the Designated Physician/Facility for the City of Milo, Iowa. Second by Mason. Ayes-All present. Motion carried. Motion by Moulds to appoint Misti Kosman as City Clerk for the City of Milo, Iowa. Second by Mason. Ayes-All. Motion carried. Motion by Uttley to appoint Robert Stuyvesant, Stuyvesant, Benton, & Judisch, 1005 Hwy 5, Carlisle, Iowa as the Designated Attorney for the City of Milo, Iowa. Second by Graham. Ayes-All present. Motion carried.

Mayor Hall appointed the following city positions: Tony Beck, Fire Chief, who was sworn in under oath to his appointment; Derek Hommer, Alternate to the Emergency 911 Board; Scott Graham, Mayor Pro-tem; Joe Kinser, Council Representative for Public Safety; Tiffany Moulds, Council Representative for Utilities; Scott Graham, Council Representative for Parks; Randy Uttley, Council Representative for Streets; and Tangelia Mason, Council Representative for General Items.

Mayor Hall recognized the current appointments within the City's Boards and stated that the Planning and Zoning Board and the Board of Adjustments each need one additional member.

Regarding Board appointments: Motion by Uttley to approve Planning and Zoning Board appointing Charles Jones to serve January 1, 2020 – December 31, 2024; Bill Mason to finish a term vacated by Richard Anderson ending December 31, 2020; Grant Minton and Bill Hembry to each serve January 1, 2020 – December 31, 2024. Second by Graham. Ayes-All present. Motion carried.

Mayor Hall then acknowledged the separate 28E Agreements that the City maintains with Warren County and with several Townships. The Warren County Sheriff's Contract expires June 30, 2023; the Warren County Building Rent contract is perpetual; Warren County Township contracts that expire December 31, 2022.

Motion by Graham to adjourn at 6:42 p.m. Second by Moulds. Ayes-All present. Motion carried.
