

UNAPPROVED MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO BUDGET WORKSHOP  
CITY HALL, 100 MAIN ST, MILO, IOWA - MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2020

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 6:36 p.m. Council answering roll call: Kinser, Moulds and Mason. Graham was absent. Uttley arrived at 6:41 p.m.

Motion by Moulds to approve the agenda. Second by Kinser. Ayes: Kinser, Moulds and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Graham and Uttley. Motion approved.

Council heard information presented by the City Clerk and Fire Chief Tony Beck regarding future funding of the Milo Fire / EMS Volunteer Department. City Council discussed using the same township equation applied to the city property tax dollars to fund a capital improvement account for future equipment updates. Tony Beck shared information for the upcoming firefighter physicals, bunker gear and equipment update schedules and the costs associated with these updates. Discussion followed. Motion by Kinser to approve creating capital improvement funds for Fire and EMS that are funded by a portion of Milo property tax dollars in accordance with the equation used by Warren County Townships. Second by Moulds. Ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Uttley and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Graham. Motion approved. Next, Council reviewed the revenue and expense budgets that the city treasurer prepared for the City of Milo with no changes being made.

Motion by Graham to adjourn at 6:58 p.m. Second by Moulds. Ayes: all present. Motion approved.
