

MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY HALL, 100 MAIN ST, MILO, IOWA - MONDAY, JUNE 23, 2020

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 7:00 p.m. Council answering roll call: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Mayor hall acknowledged that City Attorney Stuyvesant and the City Clerk were also present at this meeting.

Motion by Graham to approve the agenda. Second by Kinser. Ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Nays: none. Motion approved. Mayor Hall opened the public hearing regarding the determination by Milo City Council if a dog (Carl) is considered a vicious animal pursuant to Chapter 56 of Milo Code of Ordinances. Motion by Graham to enter all documents and pictures pertaining to the dog attack of June 9, 2020 involving Carl the dog that are part of the Milo City Council information packets into the record. Second by Kinser. Ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Nays: none. Motion approved. Mayor Hall called for comments from persons who have interacted with the dog (Carl). Mayor Hall asked all participants to state their name and address prior to giving their statements. Testimony was heard from Diane Alexander (victim of dog maul), Ken Smith (witness of dog maul), Will Coffman (witness of dog maul), Dave Minton (husband of victim), Warren County Sheriff's Officer Jon Wilbur, Milo City Clerk, Travis Kirgan (property/dog owner), Briston Kirgan (property/dog owner), Mary Garcia (neighbor to dog), Goering/Murdock family (neighbor to dog), Anna Rowe (concerned parent/citizen walker), Tony Beck (Milo Fire Chief). Council, after each piece of testimony, asked questions pertaining to the incident. Motion by Moulds to close this public hearing. Second by Mason. Ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Nays: none. Motion approved. After discussion, motion by Moulds that the dog (Carl) has been determined to be vicious pursuant to the Chapter 56 of the Milo Code of Ordinances. Second by Mason. Voice vote ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Voice vote nays: none. Motion carried. Next, after discussion, motion by Kinser to humanely euthanize the dog (Carl). Second by Moulds. Discussion followed. Voice vote ayes: Kinser, Moulds, Graham, Uttley and Mason. Voice vote nays: none. Motion carried. Attorney Stuyvesant informed Travis and Briston Kirgan, the property/dog owners, of their right to file an appeal in the Iowa District Court within ten (10) days after the order is served upon them by the Warren County Sheriff's Office. Motion by Moulds to adjourn at 8:07 p.m. Second by Mason. Ayes: all present. Motion approved.
